The WZB Research Area 'Markets & Choice' (MC) offers 2 positions for postdoctoral research associates in the summer/fall of 2021 to join the group of behavioral economists at the Berlin Social Science Center. Strong researchers with a background in applied micro and/ or experimental economics and a research focus on behavioral economics, market design or digitalization are encouraged to apply. Current research topics of the MC group at the WZB include bounded rationality, social preferences, charitable giving, market design, matching theory, educational choices, unethical behavior, and motivated beliefs. We are currently expanding our research portfolio into the field of digitalization and are interested in the ethical aspects of algorithms, the role of AI for the organization of labour in the future, and the dynamic processes that drive information flows in networks, shaping values and beliefs. The WZB is a publicly funded research institution within the Leibniz association. The academic research conducted at the WZB in the social sciences is theory-based and problem-oriented. The position at the WZB implies freedom from teaching obligations, strong administrative support for projects, grant proposals and workshop organization, access to the WZB-TU economics lab as well as many opportunities to interact with academic peers.
